Make Your Car Tough To Steal.

To make your vehicle a tough target, the Arizona Auto Theft Authority (AATA) and National Insurance Crime Bureau (NICB), recommends a "Layered Approach" to Protection. The more layers of protection on your vehicle, the tougher it is to steal.

Layer 1: Common Sense Tips

- Lock your car – half of all vehicles stolen are left unlocked
- Take your keys – nearly 20% of all vehicles stolen have the keys in them
- Park in well-lighted areas – car thefts occur at night more than half the time
- Park in attended lots – car thieves do not like witnesses
- Don't leave your car running, even for a minute – convenience stores, gas stations, and ATMs are common hunting grounds for thieves.
- Completely close your car windows
- Do not leave valuables in plain view
- Do not hide a spare set of keys in the car – the pros know where to look
- Do not leave your title in the vehicle
- Park with your wheels turned toward the curb
- Always use your emergency brake when parking
- If you have a garage, use it – and when you do, lock both, the vehicle and the garage door

Layer 2: Visible and Audible Deterrents alert thieves that your car is protected:

- Audible alarms
- Steering wheel locks
- Steering column collars
- Tire locks
- Window etching – etch vehicle identification number (VIN) on vehicle windows
- Protective window laminate
- Theft deterrent decals - such as the AATA's Free Watch Your Car Program

Layer 3: Vehicle Immobilizers prevent thieves from bypassing your ignition and hot-wiring your vehicle:

- Smart keys
- Fuse cut-offs
- Kill switches
- Starter, ignition and fuel disablers

Layer 4: Tracking Systems

A vehicle tracking system is a high-tech device designed to be hidden in your vehicle in order to emit a signal that the police can monitor if you report a theft.

The Watch Your Car program is a free, voluntary program which operates between 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM daily. Participants enroll in the program (see attached form or enroll via web site at www.azwatchyourcar.com), then receive decals, which are placed on the front and rear windows of the vehicle. If a police officer witnesses the vehicle in operation between program hours, they have the authority to stop the vehicle and verify the rightful owner is driving. To enroll, simply complete the attached application and return to the AATA. The decals will be mailed to you.

I agree that persons operating my vehicle with consent in the State of Arizona between the hours of 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM, and anytime my vehicle is within 1 mile of the international border, are subject to a police stop under circumstances in which the police reasonably suspect that the vehicle may be stolen. In these instances, police action will include the necessary precautions generally taken to protect officers when approaching a potentially stolen vehicle. I also agree specifically to advise the person to whom I give possession of the vehicle, that this agreement exists and that they will be subject to being stopped by the police during the prescribed hours. I will not authorize such person to let anyone use the vehicle. I understand that in order to withdraw from participation in this program, I must remove the decals from my vehicle and notify the Arizona Automobile Theft Authority in writing. I further agree to remove the decals prior to the sale or transfer of ownership on my participating vehicle. A sold notice (on the back of your vehicle registration) when returned to MVD and entered into the system, will serve as a cancellation to the "Watch Your Car" Program. If I change my address with MVD, my address will automatically be updated for the Watch Your Car Program. If I change my telephone number, I agree to notify AATA in writing.

I agree that I am the registered owner / authorized agent of the vehicle.
